OSAKA

- Osaka Castle (Photo Stop) it is one of Japan's most famous
- Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade A largest shopping area covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop. There are a lot of boutiques and specialty stores, including Japanese cuisine, and can enjoy the different flavors of various countries in the world.

KYOTO

- **Fushimi Inari Shrine** This is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari. famous for its thousands (over 10,000) of closely-spaced orange torii gates that wind over the hills of Inariyama beyond the entrance to the shrine. Inari was seen as the patron of business, and merchants and manufacturers have traditionally worshipped Inari.
- **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. -Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) - Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.
- Ninenzaka Path & Sannenzaka Path This is a stone road on a hillside, the Shinto of Kiyomizu Temple. Souvenir shops, pottery shops and restaurants line the roadside. Nearby are Yasaka Shrine, Maruyama Park, Kodaiji Temple, and Hokanji Temple. According to the Cultural Properties Protection Act, it is listed as an important traditional building preservation area.

NARA

Todai-ji Temple - is one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara", together with seven other sites including temples, shrines and places the Big Buddha Hall is the world's largest wooden building, despite the fact that the present reconstruction of 1692 is only two thirds of the original temple hall's size.

大阪

- **大阪城堡** 是大阪的象征,它包括十三处被日本政府立为 重要文化遗产的建筑。 **心斋桥** 大阪最大的购物区,也是日本最长的天缝式购物 街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店。

京都

奈良

东大寺-被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇圣旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国 分寺的总寺院,据说是因为建在首都平城京以东,所以被称 作"东大寺"。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造 建筑东大寺大佛殿内,放置着高15米以上的佛像。
