## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### OSAKA

- **Osaka Castle (Photo Stop)** - it is one of Japan's most famous castles.
- **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - A largest shopping area covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop. There are a lot of boutiques and specialty stores, including Japanese cuisine, and can enjoy the different flavors of various countries in the world.

### KYOTO

- **Fushimi Inari Shrine** - This is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari. famous for its thousands (over 10,000) of closely-spaced orange torii gates that wind over the hills of Inariyama beyond the entrance to the shrine. Inari was seen as the patron of business, and merchants and manufacturers have traditionally worshipped Inari.
- **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple. - Nishijin Textile Centre (Kimono Show) - Here you can find a great variety of works created in the Nishijin Spirit, like Kimono & Kimono Sashes. And you could enjoy a Kimono show in the centre.
- **Ninenzaka Path & Sannenzaka Path** - This is a stone road on a hillside, the Shinto of Kiyomizu Temple. Souvenir shops, pottery shops and restaurants line the roadside. Nearby are Yasaka Shrine, Maruyama Park, Kodaiji Temple, and Hokanji Temple. According to the Cultural Properties Protection Act, it is listed as an important traditional building preservation area.

### NARA

- **Todai-ji Temple** - is one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. The temple is a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site as "Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara", together with seven other sites including temples, shrines and places the Big Buddha Hall is the world's largest wooden building, despite the fact that the present reconstruction of 1692 is only two thirds of the original temple hall's size.

## 观光景点:

### 大阪

- **大阪城堡** - 是大阪的象征, 它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- **心斋桥** - 大阪最大的购物区, 也是日本最长的天缝式购物街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店。

### 京都

- **伏见稻荷大社** - 每年都有大量的香客前来神社祭拜求取农作丰收、生意兴隆、交通安全, 使得该神社成为京都地区香火最盛的神社之一。另外, 起源于江户时代的习俗, 前来此地许愿的人们往往会捐款在神社境内竖立一座鸟居来表达对神明敬意, 使得伏见稻荷大社的范围内竖有数量惊人的大小鸟居, 而以「千本鸟居」之名闻名日本全国乃至海外。目前现存的鸟居, 最早可以追溯到明治年间。
- **清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙, 整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各样的日本手工艺品, 陶瓷, 日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。
- **二年坂, 三年坂** - 这是一条山坡上的石板路, 即清水寺的神道。纪念品店, 陶器店和餐厅林立路旁。附近有八坂神社、圆山公园、高台寺、法观寺。根据文化财保护法, 被列为重要传统的建造物群保存地区。

### 奈良

- **东大寺** - 被列入《世界遗产名录》的东大寺是公元728年遵照重视佛教的圣武天皇圣旨建造的。东大寺是全国68所国分寺的总寺院, 据说是因为建在首都平城京以东, 所以被称作“东大寺”。正面宽度57米、深50米的世界最大的木造建筑东大寺大佛殿内, 放置着高15米以上的佛像。
