TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

 Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) - Is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.

HAKONE

 Mt. Fuji 5th Station - At 3776 meters above sea level, the Fuji Subaru Line 5th Station offers a commanding view of the Fuji Five Lakes area below, making it a popular spot even for those who are not intent on climbing the mountain.

MATSUMOTO

 Matsumoto Castle - Is one of Japan's premier historic castles, along with Himeji and Kumamoto.

TAKAYAMA

 Takayama Old Town - This is the crater of a volcanic eruption 3,000 years ago. Whenever the wind blows, thick smoke with a sulfur smell fills the air, forming a special landscape. At the mountain's top are "black eggs" cooked in volcanic hot springs. According to the Japanese, eating one can extend your life by 7 years.

SHIRAKAWA-GO

• Shirakawa-Go Village - The Historic Villages of Shirakawa-gō are one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These villages are well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gash O-zukuri. The Gasshō-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer. The design is exceptionally strong and, in combination with the unique properties of the thatching, allow the houses to withstand and shed the weight of the region's heavy snowfalls in winter.

KYOTO

 Kiyomizu Temple - Is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.

观光景点:

东京

浅草雷门观音寺 - 建于7世纪的佛庙,其象征物是风雷神门, 上面挂着写有"雷门"两个字的大红灯笼,这里每天都有前来参 拜的观光客,终年熙熙攘攘 您也可在该寿前的热闹街道"仲见 世"购物,此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当 地小吃的日式店 铺。

箱根

富士山 - 富士山海拔3776米,是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟, 为其它山峰所不 及,呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美,常常被用来作 为绘画和文学的创作题材,它作 为日本的象征,名扬全世界。

松本

松本城 - 松本城是日本最雄伟的城堡之一 共五层的天空守阁 于16世纪末建成,是日本现存最古老的天空守阁。

高山

高山古街 - 高山古街保留传统日式风格,走在日本江户时代原色古味的建筑当中,幽雅幽雅静谧的气氛,展现了日本文化传统美,是高山地区有人气旅游景点。自古以来,一直是飞驒地区(现在的岐阜县北部)经济重地的高山古街有著 「飞驒的小京

白川乡

合掌村 - 于1995年列入世界文化遗产,因为冬天的景色如同童话故事中情景一般,故被誉为『冬日的童话村』。这是日本一种特殊的民宅形式,特色是以茅 草覆盖的屋顶,呈人字型的屋顶如同双手合十一般,于是就被称为【合掌】。 合掌造为木造建筑物,在兴建的过程中完全不用钉子,但仍然十分坚固。合掌 造的屋顶十分陡峭,这是使积雪容易滑落不会堆积,以避免冬季的大雪将屋顶 压垮。

京都

清水寺 - 历史悠久的寺庙,整座建筑完全不用铁打钉琐。沿途坡道两旁是日式 古老建筑及商店,摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品,陶瓷,日本娃娃等,不胜 枚举。
